

If YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 (a temperature of over 37.3°C, dry cough, impaired breathing, loss of the sense of taste or smell, intestinal problems), then the positive antigen test result means that you are infected with COVID-19. Anybody can catch this disease, so **keep calm**, don't panic and observe the following rules so you don't pass on the disease to other people.

- Stay **at home in ISOLATION** and avoid contact with people.
- Immediately you find out your test result, contact your **general practitioner**, who will inform you on what happens next – compulsory home ISOLATION, the date on which isolation ends, official confirmation of illness for your employer etc.
- Then contact your **employer** and inform him/her of your situation.
- You will be sent a text message with a link to the website where you will find a **SELF REPORTING FORM**, which you should complete at latest by the next day.
- All those who tested positive will receive a text message with an **eRouška authorisation code** for sending the data and anonymous warnings to other users of the eRouška app.
- The local **hygiene station** will contact you to within one or two days of you reporting your test result to discuss details concerning the data that you entered into the Self Reporting Form. If the **hygiene station** does not contact you during this time, please be patient, the hygiene station has been delayed due to the current excessive workload, but it will certainly contact you soon. Even in the absence of communication from the hygiene station, you must still observe the rules for isolation.

**For the duration of your isolation, monitor your condition. If your medical condition significantly worsens, phone your general practitioner, or the Emergency Medical Service (ambulance) by phoning 155 and inform the operator that you a COVID-19 positive test result.**

**IF YOU DO NOT HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19**, but you have **a positive antigen test result**, you have undergone (or will undergo) a PCR test to confirm the result. Until you receive the result of the PCR test, which will be sent to you by text message, please **observe barrier measures to prevent transmission of disease**. If you receive a positive PCR result, observe the above instructions.

## ISOLATION

Isolation is a measure that involves the **separation of infected persons** from others. The aim is to prevent further spread of the infection. Isolation is compulsory for persons with a positive test result. Isolation is imposed by your general practitioner or a hygiene officer, who also determines the duration of isolation.
