

1 VOLUNTARY ANTIGEN TEST or SELF-PAYERS

A negative antigen test means that in your case COVID-19 was **not detected**, and therefore quarantine measures do not apply to you at this time. However, a negative test result does not exclude the possibility that you might become infectious in the period following your test.

2 YOU HAVE SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

- Even though you feel ill, COVID-19 you **tested negative** on your antigen test. You are probably suffering from a different infectious disease.
- Contact your **general practitioner** (physician) and inform him/her of your test result and discuss with his/her how to proceed.
- If your medical condition significantly worsens, contact the Emergency Medical Service (ambulance) by phoning 155.
- Observe barrier measures against transmission of illness.

If you find that you have symptoms of COVID-19 (a temperature of over 37.3°C, dry cough, impaired breathing, loss of the sense of taste or smell, intestinal problems), contact your general practitioner and discuss with his/her how to proceed.
